Introduction



Perimeter Zone

DUCTED FAN HEATING AND COOLING

Traditionally, fan terminals have been used to provide variable heating and cooling to the perimeter. The fan terminal is equipped with either a hot water coil or an electric heater. Air is forced through the fan and then introduced into the space through floor grilles. A thermostat monitors the room temperature, while the PCM onboard the fan terminal modulates the fan and heating device to meet the space requirements.

Linear Floor Plenum


The Linear Floor Plenum (LFP) is designed to be used in conjunction with the Linear Floor Grille (LFG) to provide fan-forced air to the space for either heating or cooling.

The LFP is available in a floor tile supported model to be used with grilles with flanges, and in a pedestal supported model to allow the use of flangeless grille options. Both of these plenum styles can be installed for a continuous-look grille application using the Underfloor Blank-off (UFB).



INSTALLATION & MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

Floor Tile Supported Installation

STEP 1: The floor opening should be the same size as the nominal size used to order the floor plenum.

STEP 2: Connect flexible ductwork to inlet on floor plenum.

STEP 3: Set floor plenum into floor opening so that the support flange rests above the tile.

OPTIONAL: For continuous applications, remove end-cap and follow instructions in the UFB manual for blank-off installation.

STEP 4: Place floor grille into plenum.

Pedestal Supported Installation

STEP 1: The floor opening should be the same size as the nominal size used to order the floor plenum.

STEP 2: Connect flexible ductwork to inlet on floor plenum.

STEP 3: Slide pedestal heads through slot in pedestal brackets to attach to floor pedestals. Adjust height to achieve an even finish with the floor.

OPTIONAL: For continuous applications, remove end-cap and follow instructions in the UFB manual for blank-off installation.

STEP 4: Place floor grille into plenum.

FIGURE 1: FLOOR TILE SUPPORT ASSEMBLY ▼





FIGURE 2: PEDESTAL SUPPORTED ASSEMBLY ▼
