STANDARD CEILING CONFIGURATIONS



Lay-in T-Bar ceiling systems come in many styles and configurations. Selecting the correct border style for a diffuser is essential to ensure performance of the diffuser is maintained and the desired appearance within the ceiling system is achieved. The information required to select the correct diffuser border style is, the ceiling tile type, ceiling system tee size, and module size. The table below provides some guidance to select diffuser border styles for the most common suspended ceiling configurations and diffusers.




STANDARD CEILING CONFIGURATIONS



CORRECT SELECTION REQUIRES THE FOLLOWING DETAILS:

- + Ceiling grid tee width (9/16" or 15/16")
- + Ceiling tile edge detail (Tegular, Beveled, Flat, Concealed etc.)
- + Panel/module size (standard is usually 24"x24")
- + System color
